Financial Secretary Report (Mike Ilderton)

Due notices have gone out. Please pay as soon as possible. Membership is \$43 Honorary Member is \$28 and Honorary Life member no dues. Alex Papp and Rick Boedicker will be getting their Honorary Life Membership. This is 70 years old and 25 years of service.

I have been working with the High Point Rockers. We have been talking and emailing, after changing paperwork a few times, the said we should receive our check for \$5,600 in 2 - 3 weeks. 3,600 from the games and 2,000 from the Wake Forest game.

As for the 75th anniversary. In October the council committed to \$ 10,000. Mike spoke with Barbara to determine if the Church spent that amount.
