- **Form 185** – Report of Officers Chosen – June 30, 2026.

All fourteen (14) positions should be filled.

- **Form 365** – Service Program Personnel – July 1, 2026.

At a minimum, four (4) of the positions are required. These are:

- Grand Knight (may also fill one other position)
- Program Director
- Family Director (with background check)
- Community Director (with background check)
- Best practices indicate that two (2) Membership Directors be appointed in Parishes with large Hispanic membership; one (1) English speaking and one (1) Spanish speaking.

- **Form SP-7** - Columbian Award Application – June 20, 2026

- **Form #1295** - Semiannual (now annual) Council Audit – August 15, 2026

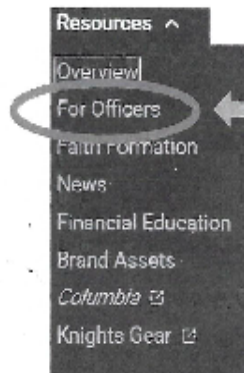
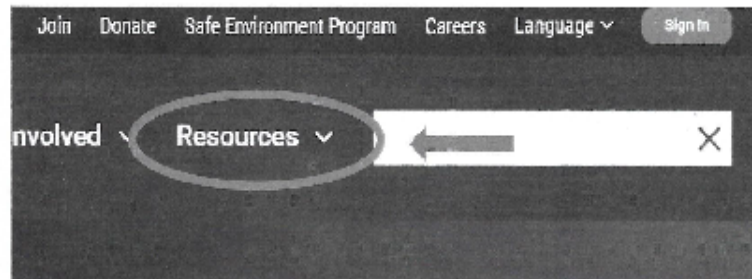

How to get access to form 10784 if you are not the Grand Knight or Financial Secretary. First go to the KofC Supreme website: www.kofc.org, but with the new Supreme KofC website redesign, there is a new path to the Form 10784 for non-officers to complete them. Below is the guide to streamline the search for the 10784 for non-officer members.
